


Page Header Installation Instructions for SharePoint 2013/2016/2019/SE

1. Unpack the **AEPageHeaderWebpart.wsp** and **Install2013/2016/2019.bat** files from the Zip Archive and place the 2 files onto your Sharepoint Server.
2. Add the Solution by either running **Install20xx.bat** or manually entering:
stsadm -o addsolution -filename AEPageHeaderWebpart.wsp
3. Deploy the solution by navigating with your browser to “Central Administration > System Settings > Farm Management > Manage farm solutions”:




4. You should now see the **AEPageHeaderWebpart.wsp** in the farm’s solution store:




Click on “aepageheaderwebpart.wsp” to deploy the solution:



5. Proceed to activate the feature by navigating to the “Site Actions/Site Settings” page in your top-level Sharepoint site:




Choose “Site collection features” to navigate to the Site Collection Features page:



Activate the “AE Page Header Web Part” feature.

You now can click the “AE Page Header settings” link at the bottom of the “Site Collection Features” section to open the Page Header configuration:
